MSM Sugar Refinery (Johor) Sdn Bhd, a subsidiary of MSM Malaysia Holdings Bhd operating MSM's new sugar refinery based in Tanjung Langsat, here is set to be the largest standalone sugar refinery in Malaysia.

Located on a 125.58ha plot in the integrated complex here, the first phase of the Johor sugar refinery aims to produce 3,000 tonnes per day of refined sugar output (RSO) contributing to one million metric tonnes out of the group's annual production capacity.

The company said in a statement that the first phase of development would cost USD\$259 million (RM1.09 billion).

"Upon completion and full commissioning of MSM Johor, the total group production capacity will increase to up to 3.25 million metric tonnes per annum," said the statement.

A ground-breaking ceremony for the MSM Sugar Refinery (Johor) Sdn Bhd plant was launched today by Johor Legislative Assembly speaker, Tan Sri Mohamad Aziz, who represented Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Mohamed Khaled Nordin.

Also present were MSM Malaysia Holdings Bhd chair Tan Sri Mohd Isa Abdul Samad and MSM Malaysia Holdings Bhd president and group chief executive officer Datuk Sheikh Awab Sheikh Abod.
