MSM plans RM220m capacity expansion

36PC INCREASE: Firm targets sugar output of 1.5m tonnes by 2016

producer, will increase its refined sugar output by 36 per cent, or 400,000 tonnes, to 1.5 million tonnes by 2016.

MSM is setting aside RM220 million from the RM413.8 million raised from its listing in 2011 for this internal expansion.

The company has used RM130 million of the proceeds, out of which RM37 million was for capital expenditure and RM97 million for working capital.

Chief executive officer Chua Say Sin said for this year alone, MSM has budgeted RM85 million for capacity and warehouse expansion.

It has also set aside RM100 million

SM Malaysia Holdings Bhd, for strategic acquisitions to expand per day. the country's largest sugar its sugar cane planting into Southeast Asia.

Chua, however, said the plan to go upstream overseas needs more stud-

"We are still conservative on this as it is a big investment and due to the bearish outlook of world sugar prices," he said after MSM's annual general meeting here yesterday.

The production increase plan is to meet increasing demand and to explore new international markets.

particularly in Asia Pacific, he said.

While the investment in capacity expansion is in anticipation of production of raw sugar melt growing from 3,600 tonnes to 4,600 tonnes

"We also intend to increase the raw sugar storage capacity further to

37,000 tonnes from 27,000 tonnes currently," he added.

MSM targets to increase it exports to 20 per cent of total output by yearend from 15 per cent recorded in 2012, with the main focus on the Asian market.

'We just ventured into the Myan-

mar market and we are now looking at Vietnam due to its big population," he added.

Last year, MSM sold 751,668 tonnes of refined sugar domestically, while export sales rose by 3.5 per cent to 159,409 tonnes from 153,964 tonnes.
